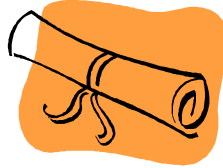


Congratulations Judith!

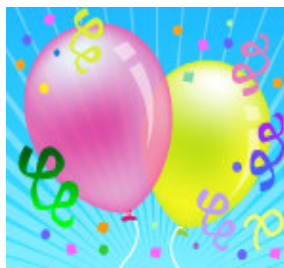
Priest Judith completed her doctorate last month

Emrich Deanery to Sponsor
Anti-racism Training

The Emrich Area Deanery, of which Trinity is a member, is planning to organize and sponsor an anti-racism training program in the fall of 2009. The anti-racism training is required for church members in leadership positions. Mr. James Perkinson of the Ecumenical Theological Seminary of Detroit will be invited to open the training session and our Diocesan training team will assist in completing the training needed for leadership certification.

The Emrich Deanery is a grouping of churches in the greater Detroit area. They have been working together on a regular basis to pool resources and share ministry ideas for the benefit of all congregations involved and the diocese in general. 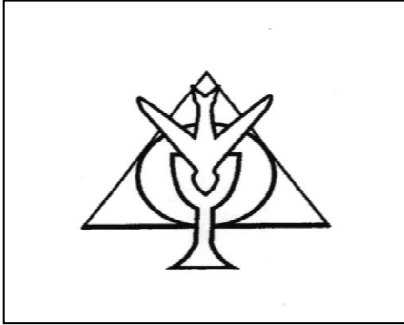
